**NOTICE AND ORDER TO APPEAR
(CONTEMPT)**

**FORM 8
Instructions**

- _____ Print the name of the plaintiff (the person who initiated the original action) exactly as it appears on all other forms in this action.
- _____ Print the name of the defendant (the person who the original action was filed against) exactly as it appears on all other forms in this action.
- _____ Print the case number that has been assigned to your case (this can be found on your custody complaint or custody order.)
- _____ Insert the current address and phone number of the opposing party.

Attach the completed Notice and Order to Appear FORM 8 to the front of the Petition for Civil Contempt for Disobedience of Custody Order FORM 7.

If you do not appear in person for the conference, the Court may issue a Warrant for your arrest. This is why you should make sure that Child Custody Services has your correct mailing address.

If the court finds that you have willfully failed to comply with its order for legal custody or physical custody, you may be found to be in contempt of court and committed to jail, fined or both.
