

A special meeting of the Fayette County Board of Commissioners was held at 1:30 p.m. on Tuesday, December 9, 2014 in the commissioner's meeting room of the Fayette County Courthouse, Uniontown, Pa.

Commissioner Zapotosky called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m., announcing that the purpose of the meeting was to propose a budget for the year 2015.

**Commissioner Zapotosky** said the 2015 proposed budget reads as follows: revenues, \$27,657,391; expenditures, \$30,262,410, with a remainder of \$2,605,019. He said the millage rate for 2015 will remain the same, again this is the proposed budget.

**A motion** was made by Commissioner Zimmerlink and seconded by Commissioner Zapotosky to propose a 2015 general fund budget with revenues of \$27,657,391; expenditures of \$30,262,410, and a deficit of \$2,605,019.

**Motion passed 2-0-1**

**Commissioner Zapotosky** said let the record indicate that the measure was adopted 2 to 0 with one abstention. He said if he may for the record commissioner, abstaining is based on a conflict, can you cite the conflict that you have based this on as a commissioner in your capacity? Commissioner Ambrosini said yes, absolutely, my abstention is based on the fact that we started this process with our financial consultant Susquehanna Group, and we partway through this process, we ceased to use his services, and as long as I have been in this office we have used Susquehanna Group and specifically the services of Mr. Sam Lynch, and he has been nothing but

professional and has provided high quality services to us and I feel neither confident that this process will go in a complete or accurate manner without his services, especially since we terminated his services partway through this process. Commissioner Zapotosky said thank you, he does look forward to elaborating more on that in the near future.
