**4. Fayette County Redevelopment Authority:**

Consider adoption of a resolution to approve the submission of an application requesting funding of \$464,800 through the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Program. The approval will authorize the commissioners to sign and submit the application for assistance and will also approve execution of a cooperation agreement that highlights the Redevelopment Authority's responsibilities for administration of the ESG program on behalf of the county.

Consider adoption of a resolution to approve a 2016 competitive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application for a water system improvement project in the Mudd Pike and Braddock Road area of Henry Clay Township in the amount of \$750,000. The approval will authorize the commissioners to sign and submit the application for assistance and will also approve execution of a cooperation agreement with highlights the Redevelopment Authority's responsibilities for administration of the CDBG funding.

Consider adoption of a resolution which authorizes the Redevelopment Authority to make budget revisions to the county's fiscal year 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 Community development Block Grant (CDBG) programs.

Consider adoption of a resolution which approves a modification to Washington Township's FY 2011 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program in the amount of \$46,700.

Consider adoption of a resolution which authorizes the Redevelopment Authority to make budget revisions to the county's Fiscal Year 2014 Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) program.

**5. Assessment Office:**

Consider approval of the Court Order that outlines the settlement agreement between Wal-Mart Real Estate Business Trust and the Fayette County Board of Assessment Appeals. The Court Order sets the assessed value beginning tax year 2016 (Jan. 1 2016) at \$11,580,000. Refund amounts for the tax years 2010-2015 and repayment terms are set forth in Exhibit A in the Court Order and detailed below. The Court Order has been signed by the School District and Township. For tax year 2016, a correction of assessed value from \$13,883,050 to \$11,580,000. The refund due for 2016 is \$12,700.12. Consider adoption of a resolution for a settlement agreement between Spirit SPE Portfolio and the Fayette County Board of Assessment Appeals, Court Case (3735 of 2008, G.D.). The signing of the final order is contingent upon agreement among all parties with an interest in the appeal. National Envelope Corp, NE OP CO, Cenveo , Spirit Portfolio and United States Bankruptcy Court. The proposed settlement sets the assessed value at \$4,260,000 for the tax years 2009-2014. The assessed value reverts back to the current assessment of \$6,676,090 for tax years 2015 & 2016.

The county refund liability for tax years 2009-2014 is \$58,487.39. Repayment terms over two years would be \$29,243.70 in 2016 and \$29,243.70 in 2017. Requisitioned from (GL Org Code 014136) (GL Object # 52416) Appeals Refunds.

**14. Planning, Zoning and Community Development Office:**

Total Project Cost is estimated at \$164,580.00. Required match is \$24,687.00. Also, consider approval of the \$100.00 grant submission fee.

Consider awarding a five-year contract to the low bidder and current contractor, ABL Management Inc., for RFP 16-04 for Inmate Food Services. The contractor has significantly reduced the cost for providing their services to the Prison for the next five years resulting in an annual cost savings of approximately \$40,000 and a total five year savings of approximately \$200,000.

Consider approving Addendum No. 3 to the Prison's Vending Agreement with DSI-ITI providing for inmate phone services. The addendum is necessary to bring the terms of the agreement into compliance with recent Federal Communications Commission (FCC) rate caps and regulation for inmate interstate phone calls. The Prison never received commissions on

inmate interstate phone calls and the addendum should have no effect on phone commissions currently received.
