**COOPERATION AGREEMENT**

MADE as of this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2015, by and between FAYETTE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, hereinafter referred to as "Fayette County", a body corporate and politic in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania,

the REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF FAYETTE, PENNSYLVANIA, hereinafter referred to as the "Redevelopment Authority", a body corporate and politic created under the provisions of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Urban Redevelopment Law, hereinafter referred to as the "URL", maintaining its principal office in the City of Uniontown, Fayette County, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, the PA Race Horse Development and Gaming Act (Act 2004-71) as amended has established the Pennsylvania Gaming Local Share Account (LSA) under the Commonwealth Financing Authority (CFA) for the purpose of distributing 2% of gross terminal revenues of certain licensed gaming facilities in an orderly and timely fashion to support and enhance community and economic well-being and mitigate the impact of gaming and related activities; and

WHEREAS, an LSA has been established by the CFA for Fayette County due to gaming revenues generated by the Lady Luck Casino at Nemacolin Woodlands Resort in Wharton Township, Fayette County; and

WHEREAS, Fayette County wishes to establish guidelines in order to facilitate a local process for administration and implementation of the Fayette County Local Share Account Program; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 35 P.S. § 1709 of the URL, the Redevelopment Authority constitutes a public body, corporate and politic, exercising public powers of the Commonwealth as an agency thereof, which powers shall include all powers necessary or appropriate to carry out and effectuate the purposes and provisions of the URL; and

WHEREAS, 35 P.S. § 1709 (c) of the URL further stipulates that the Redevelopment Authority has the power to cooperate with any government, school district, or municipality; and

WHEREAS, 35 P.S. § 1741, known as the Redevelopment Cooperation Law, authorizes the County to cooperate with the Redevelopment Authority, including entering into agreements, with or without consideration, to perform the services stipulated in this Agreement; and

WHEREAS; the Redevelopment Authority serves as the principal agency in Fayette County responsible for implementing community development and single-family affordable housing initiatives, utilizing a variety of local, state, and federal funding resources; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the PA Race Horse Development and Gaming Act (Act 2004-71), the Redevelopment Authority is an eligible applicant for LSA funding through the CFA; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Authority has demonstrated the capacity to perform the services stipulated in this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The County hereby designates the Redevelopment Authority as the local administrator of the Fayette County Local Share Account (LSA) Program. As administrator, the Redevelopment Authority will be responsible for working with the CFA on behalf of the County to establish Program Guidelines. Once the guidelines are established and approved by the Commonwealth, the Redevelopment Authority will be responsible for planning and administration of Fayette County's LSA Program, including:
  - a. Facilitating annual planning of LSA-eligible activities working in cooperation with the County and other economic and community development agencies in the County;
  - b. Preparing and submitting applications for LSA funding through the CFA;
  - c. Be responsible for financial administration, including the requisition of funds, the maintenance of books of account, and the carrying out of all required audit procedures.
  - d. Administer and supervise program activities for which funding is provided in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations governing the activities of the Authority.
  - e. Review and supervise the work of other agencies and bodies which have input in the execution of project activities;
  - f. Prepare all writing materials and reports;
  - g. Recommend actions appropriate for the County to take in furtherance of the LSA Program.
2. Prior to submitting any applications to the CFA for LSA funding, the Redevelopment Authority shall first obtain approval of the application by the County Commissioners;
3. The Redevelopment Authority will provide reports to the County, as requested, on its activities related to administration of the Fayette County LSA Program. The Redevelopment Authority will attend all requested meetings with the County and other officials or organizations.
4. Payments for costs to administer the implementation of the Fayette County LSA Program, including, but not limited to salaries, operational, and indirect costs, shall be paid through the LSA Program in accordance with and as determined by the terms and conditions of future contracts between the Redevelopment Authority and the Commonwealth.
5. Redevelopment Authority Coverages. The Redevelopment Authority shall purchase and maintain full force the following coverages:
  - a. Comprehensive General Liability insurance, in the aggregate of \$1,000,000.
  - b. Comprehensive Automobile Liability insurance with a single limit of \$1,000,000.
  - c. Worker's Compensation and Employer's Liability insurance, with a limit of \$100,000 for each occurrence.
  - d. Honesty Bond Coverage, in the amount of \$100,000 for any officer or employee.

6. Reimbursement and Hold Harmless. It is specifically understood by the County that the Authority has no funds or other assets to support and sustain its existence and continued operation other than funds received by it from various municipalities and governmental agencies which are reserved for specific purposes. Therefore, to insure the continued existence of the Authority for the purposes of its incorporation, the County agrees to reimburse any expenditures related to this initiative found by the Commonwealth to be ineligible.
  
7. Notices. All notices and reports required to be given and made by each of the parties hereto to the other in the carrying out of the project shall be given and made:
  - a. If by the County, to the Executive Director of the Authority, or his designee, and
  - b. If by the Authority, to the Board of Commissioners, or its designee.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound hereby, have caused this Agreement to be duly executed the day and year first above written.
