Population Report: As of today April 28th 2010 there are 268 inmates, 240 males 28 females with 13 females and 6 males being housed out of county. Warden Miller attended the last District Justice Meeting and was told that the reason so many are being incarcerated are because of the new laws. District Attorney Jack Heneks also spoke to the new laws.

Warden Miller also stated that his Jail rental line item for the 2010 year is almost maxed, and that Collateral is now being collected at the prison.

Warden Miller informed the board that the State inspectors were at the prison the previous week and he is awaiting the final report. Once he receives it he will distribute it to the board for review.

Controller Sean Lally spoke about the audit being performed on the accounts within the prison, he expects that the reports will be completed before the next meeting.

Commissioner Zapotosky spoke about how he would like to make sure and review both reports prior to the next meeting.
